
COLLEGE FOODSERVICE SNAPSHOT

The 2011 College & University Census comprises a mix of large, medium and small institutions. (Previously, the census reported on 50 of the largest universities.) Seventy percent of the universities surveyed are self-managed. The 30% of institutions that are contract foodservice represent 10 management companies. Highlights from the survey:

- Enrollment for the 2009-2010 academic year averaged 11,376 students, about a 2% increase over the average enrollment for the previous year. On average, 61% of the students were commuters and 39% were residents. (26% of the colleges are commuter-only campuses.)
- Among those institutions where students can live on campus, an average of **2,693** students contributed \$8.7 million in revenue.
- 98% of campuses offer cash facilities on their campuses; 92% offer catering; 66% offer vending and 14% offer athletic concessions. The average revenues for these types of operations were: cash ops, \$2.4 million; catering, \$97,682; vending, \$621,764, and concessions, \$128,631.
 - Total foodservice costs averaged \$7.6 million, with food and labor costs accounting for 84% of expenses.
 - 64% of campuses employ an executive chef, and 42% feature a market-style servery as one of their foodservice options. Of those who have such a facility, 71% have placed it in a residence hall, 29% in a student center and 19% in an academic building.


86% of institutions surveyed source at least some products locally. What they buy:


Cash operations are big business on college campuses, with virtually every respondent in charge of some retail facilities. The most popular options on campus:
